What is ACUITY?

Acuity is an all-in-one system for improving student achievement. Acuity provides interim and formative assessments designed to inform teaching and improve student learning.

How is ACUITY utilized in Franklin Township?

All students (3rd grade & up) take Acuity Tests as an ISTEP indicator. Once your child takes the Online assessments, the computer generates a report that predicts the likelihood of your child passing ISTEP, if the test were given on that day. Teachers use Acuity to help them target specific state standards that a student is lacking, and assign specific tutorial assignments through Acuity to re-teach and practice the unmastered skill. Teachers also analyze the overall classroom data and incorporate the lower scored skilled into classroom lessons.

What can I do to help my child improve his or her Acuity Scores ?

1. Use the Acuity home login, which is listed below, and help your child work through the tutorials assigned to your child by the teacher.
2. Contact your child's teacher to set up a meeting to learn the specific standards that your child needs the most help with for this school year.
