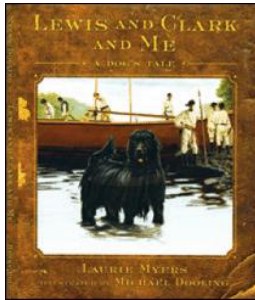

- 6. yearned:** felt a longing or desire

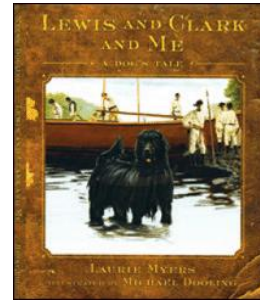
