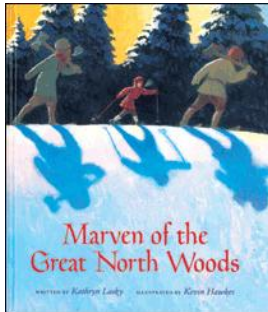

- 5. payroll:** list of persons to be paid and the amount that each one is to receive

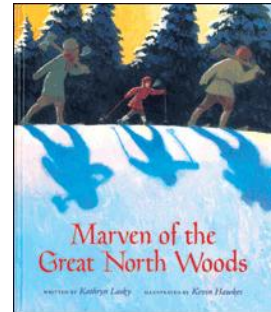
