Names: Joe, Mike, Mr. Brown, April, Tuesday, McDonalds

Numbers: 3, March 3rd, \$3, 3 miles, 6 years, -20, 7 hours

Sensory Details: Smells, Tastes, Feeling, Seeing, Hearing

Comparisons: My baseball was the same size as medium-sized frog

Figurative Language: Bang!; scary, stormy night; busy as a bee

Rules of Three: List adjectives, nouns or verbs in 3's

Action-based dialogue: "Shh, mom is coming," said Mike.
